In order to further improve access routes to the three major Japanese metropolises (Tokyo, Osaka, and Nagoya), Ishikawa Prefecture is promoting the development of high-standard arterial highways. At the same time, the prefecture also aims to construct new east-west and north-south highways as the traffic foundation for broader regional exchange and cooperation.

In the case of Komatsu Airport, the prefecture is working to create new demand in passenger and cargo transport and is planning to increase air routes. The prefecture is also taking steps, such as reducing noise pollution, to improve the living environment around the airport.

After Noto Airport became operational in July 2003, travel time to Tokyo was considerably reduced, increasing the flow of people to and from Tokyo. Today, Noto Airport has become a hub facility in the region, contributing effectively to the region's revitalization.

Along with the Hokuriku Shinkansen from Kanazawa which is set to be in service by the end of the 2014 fiscal year, Ishikawa Prefecture is also working as quickly as possible for the completion of a Shinkansen line that extends between Kanazawa and Tsuruga which will ultimately fully expand to Osaka.


小松空港については、旅客・貨物の需要開拓と航空路線の拡充を図るとともに、騒音対策など周辺の生活環境 整備にも積極的に取り組んでいます。

能登空港については、2003年7月に開港し、首都圏との移動時間が大幅に短縮されたことにより、交流人口 の拡大が図られているとともに、空港を地域の拠点施設として有効活用することで地域の活性化に効果をもたら しています。

北陸新幹線については、2014年度末までの金沢開業をはじめ、金沢・敦賀間の大幅な工期短縮による早期完成、 大阪までのフル規格による早期全線整備に向けて努力しています。


## NUMBER OF MOTOR VEHICLES OWNED BY TYPE (自動車車種別保有台数)
