In order to promote lifelong learning, the prefecture is striving to establish a Lifelong Learning Promotion System and is also working toward creating an active and appealing society with creative and open-minded individuals.

Ishikawa is working to enhance a variety of cultural facilities to promote culture; moreover, the prefecture is committed to increasing opportunities to experience high-quality art culture as well as to the preservation and utilization of cultural assets.

In order to meet citizens' diversified needs in the area of sports, the prefecture is also developing the infrastructure for sports activities. In addition, the prefecture is working on the enrichment of various age-specific sports activities in order to enable the people of Ishikawa to lead healthy and active lives.

EDUCATION, CULTURE AND SPORTS (教育・文化・スポーツ)

As of March 2011, the percentage of students continuing onto senior high schools (after finishing 9 years of education) was 99.0% with 54.8% moving onto tertiary education and junior college, both figures above the national average. The prefecture aims to develop individuals with strong spirits and rich minds full of creativity, and is also promoting the creation of dynamic and distinctive schools.

In addition, Ishikawa is making efforts to further the development of educational environments, improve the quality of teaching staff, enrich special needs education, and promote private school education.

石川県の2011年3月卒業者の高等学校進学率は99.0%、大学・短期大学への進学率は54.8%といずれも全国平均を上回っています。県では、たくましい気概と豊かな心を持ち、創造性に満ちた人間育成を目指し、活力のあふれた学校、特色ある学校づくりを進めています。

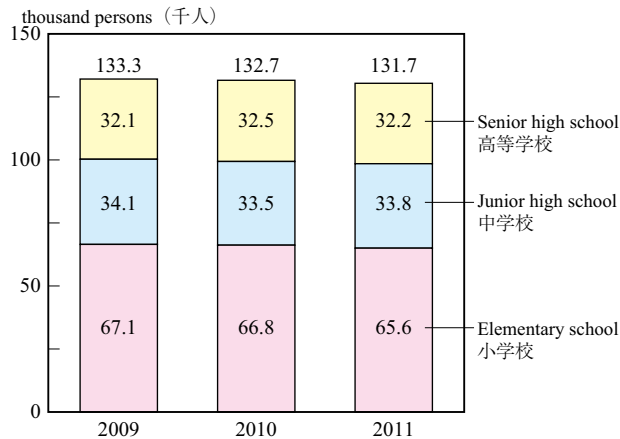
